The Family will aim to:

- Encourage the child to develop independence.
- Encourage the child to be in control of his/her behaviour.
- See the child attends regularly and on time (arrive 8.50am to start at 9.00am).
- Collect the child punctually at 3.15pm.
- See that the child wears the school uniform and is properly equipped for all activities.
- Inform the school, by phone, if the child will not be attending school that day.
- Make sure a note of explanation is provided when the child returns after absence.
- Let the school know of any concerns or problems that may affect the child's learning.
- Support the child in any opportunities for home learning.
- Attend Parents' Evening and Open Afternoons to discuss the child's progress and see the work of the school.
- Ensure that the child does not take holidays in term time.
- Use social networking sites responsibly and ensure that the reputation of the school and the staff is not compromised by inappropriate postings.

The School will endeavour to:

- Encourage children to learn as much as they can and do their best at all times.
- Set the children appropriate targets for improvement
- Encourage children to respect each other.
- Encourage children to take care of their surroundings.
- Let parents know of any concerns regarding their child's work or behaviour.
- Inform parents of non-attendance after registration (for safety reasons) by 9.30 am.
- Inform parents of children's progress at regular Parent/Teacher Interviews,
 Open Afternoons, and in the Summer Term written reports.
- Send parents a Class Letter at the beginning of each term highlighting some aspects of the planned teaching and other class activities for the term.
- Keep parents informed about general school matters.
- Welcome parents and friends of the school to help us in a variety of ways.
- Keep the children safe on the internet.

The Pupil will try to keep the School's Golden Rules:

- I will aim to be friendly to everyone.
- I will aim to work hard to meet my targets.
- I will try hard at all times with my work.
- I will talk quietly in the school building.
- I will try to be helpful to all children and adults.
- I will walk when inside the building taking care not to cause an accident.
- I will respect all school equipment and the school building.
- I will respect the IT code of conduct.

Together we will:

- Strive to make the children of Feering well-rounded people who care for others.
- Encourage the children to respect the School's Golden Rules.
- Support the children's learning to help them achieve their potential.
- Monitor and track the children's progress.
- Keep the children safe.
