In Maths we have been focusing on addition. We began by adding objects, we moved onto adding pictures (things we cannot move) and then we learnt how to use a number line to add numbers up to 20. This week we have focused on subtraction and have learnt different ways to subtract.

How you can support at home in Maths:

- Practise writing numbers 0-20, correcting any numbers that are written backwards, this is something that really needs practising as lots of children are reversing their numbers.
- Add one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20 using objects/ pictures/ number line.
- Practise recalling number bonds to 10.

In English last week we finished exploring Hairy Maclary and the children completed their Big Write which was about writing instructions on how to look after a dog. This week we have started reading 'The Enormous Turnip'. The children have been learning the story and writing captions to match parts of the story. They especially enjoyed adding actions to
